KINDERGARTEN – 1 backpack, 1 set watercolor paints, 1 wide rule spiral notebook, 1 smock or large old shirt for painting, empty shoe box, 6 glue sticks, 1 box of crackers to share, 1 box of Crayola markers –primary colors, 2 boxes 8crayons, 1 bottle school glue, 1 box of snack size Ziploc bags, 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags, 1 large box of Kleenex, 1 Container of Clorox Wipes, \$5.00 for film processing.

1ST GRADE - 1 set of watercolor paints, 1 box of 24 crayons, 1 box classic markers, 12 #2 pencils with child's name on them, 2 large eraser, Fiskar scissors, 3 bottles Elmer's White School Glue, pencil box, old large shirt, 1 large box of Kleenex, 5 pocket folders with 3 ring fasteners (Do not label with name), 1 composition notebook, 1 box Ziplock bags – any size

2ND GRADE - 1 small pencil box, 36 pencils, 3 pocket folders with bottom pocket & brads to attach papers, 1 box thin line markers, 1, one inch 3 ring binder, 1 box crayons, 1 box 12 colored pencils, 1 pair Fiskar scissors, 3 large glue sticks, 1 set of 8 watercolors (traditional colors), 2 large erasers, 1 box of Kleenex, 1 box of quart size and 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags, 2 boxes of crackers, 2 spiral notebooks (wide-ruled)

THIRD GRADE - 1 small pencil box, 24 pencils with names on them, 1 ruler, 2 spiral notebooks (non-release paper ONLY), 3 folders w/pockets, 1 box traditional color markers, 1 box 24 crayons, 1 box 12 colored pencils, 1 large box Kleenex, 2 glue sticks, 1 large eraser, 1 pair Fiskar scissors, 1 paint shirt, 2 plastic folders with pockets, 1 package wide ruled notebook paper, 1 small bottle of Elmer's glue

2ND & 3RD GRADE COMBINATION –24 pencils, 1 ruler, 3 folders with pockets, 1 box markers, traditional colors, 1 box 24 crayons, 1 box 12 colored pencils, 1 large box Kleenex, 6 glue sticks, 1 large eraser, 1 pair Fiskar scissors, 1 paint shirt, 3 one & half inch 3-ring binders, 1 spiral notebook, 1 container of antibacterial wipes, 1 container of waterless antibacterial soap

4TH GRADE & 4TH & 5TH GRADE COMBINATION & 5TH GRADE – 10solid colored pocket folders with three-hole clasp, 4 spiral notebooks – 1 subject (non removable pages) different colors, 1 pack wide ruled notebook paper, 4 dozen #2 pencils (plain), 3 large glue sticks, 3pk colored pencils, 1 ruler (standard & metric measurement), 3 highlighters (1 yellow, 1 pink, 1 green) 2 pair fine point scissors, 1 box broad line markers, 1 box quart or gallon size Ziploc bags, 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 black thick Sharpie permanent marker, 1 black fine point Sharpie permanent marker, 3 red grading pens

6TH GRADE – 3 wide ruled, one subject spiral notebooks, 1 packages loose leaf notebook paper, wide ruled, 1 two inch three-ring binder - zip style, 3 box of #2 pencils, 1 sturdy pencil bag (with holes to keep in three ring binder and big enough to fit pencils, pens, markers & ruler), 2 colored pens of your choice (not blue or black), 1 box Kleenex, 1 box broad tip markers, 1 box of 12 or 24 colored pencils, 1 pair scissors, 1 bottle of rubber cement, 1 plastic ruler with metric and standard, 1 package 3x5 lined white index cards, 1 package highlighters, 4 pocket folders (bottom pockets) – need to have holes so they can be fastened in a 3 ring binder, 1 package multiplication flash cards, 1 basic calculator, 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags (last name ending A – M), 1 box quart size Ziploc bags (last name ending N – Z), 1 T-shirt (no tank tops or sleeveless styles), 1 pair of sport shorts (no cut offs) must follow school dress guidelines for length, 1 combination lock required (no key or laser locks allowed)

7TH & 8TH GRADE - 1 packages **wide -ruled** loose leaf notebook paper, 1 pkg. 1 cm x 1cm graph paper, 2 two inch three ring binders (one for social studies and one for math), 3 boxes of #2 pencils, 1 pkg. 8 ½ x 11 construction paper (assorted colors), 6 pens (blue or black) **no gel pens**, 4 single subject spiral notebooks for Literacy journals, 1 box Kleenex, 1 box markers, 1 box of 12 or 24 colored pencils, 1 pair of good scissors, 1 bottle of glue or rubber cement, 1 pkg. 3x3 sticky notes, 1 ruler with metric and standard, 2 pkgs. 3 x 5 lined white index cards, 1 pkg. Highlighters, 6 pocket folders (bottom pockets) need to have holes for binder, 1 scientific calculator, 1 protractor and compass (non metal) 2 pair gym shoes with non-marking soles (one pair for inside and one for outside), 1 t-shirt (no tank tops or sleeveless styles), 1 pair of sport shorts (no cut offs) must follow school dress guidelines for length, 1 combination lock required (no key or laser locks allowed)

SCHOOL BUS ROUTING

Milner Route

The bus shall proceed east on Jefferson Ave./US 40 to Milner, south on RCR 179/Main St., Milner, turn around in Milner, west on US 40, south on RCR 27, turn around at 36190 RCR 27, north on RCR 27, west on US 40, Jefferson Ave., north on Ash St., west on Lincoln Ave., south on Aspen St., west on Jefferson Ave. then to HHS/HMS and HVE.

Elkhead Route

The bus shall proceed east on Jefferson Ave., north on Walnut St./RCR 80, north on RCR 76, west on RCR 78 to MCR 28, south on MCR 29/RCR 86, east on US 40 to Hayden to Meadow Village Trailer Park, east on Jefferson Ave., north on 4th St., east on Lincoln St., south on 2nd St., east on Jefferson Ave. to HHS/HMS and HVE.

Hayden Divide Route

The bus shall proceed south on Poplar St./RCR 53, east on RCR 29 to the turn around near 5315 RCR, west on RCR 29, north on RCR 53/Poplar St. to HHS/HMS and HVE.

North Cog/Breeze Basin

The bus shall proceed east on Jefferson Ave., north on Walnut St./ RCR 80, north on RCR 76, turn around at 46655 RCR 76, south on RCR 76, north on RCR 74A, turn around at 43250RCR 74A, north on RCR 74A north on RCR 76, west on RCR 76A, turn around at 40875 RCR 76A, east on RCR 76A, south on RCR 76, north on RCR 80 turn around at 41090 RCR 80, south on RCR 80 to Walnut St., west on Jefferson Ave. onto HHS/HMS, south on Third St., west on Breeze Basin Blvd./RCR 65 turn around at 5980 RCR 65, east on RCR 65 to HHS/HMS and HVE.

Sage Creek Route

The bus will go east on Jefferson Ave. south on Hawthorne St./RCR 37 to the Coyote Creek Ranch turn around, north on RCR 37 to Hawthorne St., west on Crandall Ave., north on Santa Fe Dr., east on Vista Verde Dr., east on Crandall Ave., north on Hawthorne St, west on Shelton Lane, west on Washington Ave. to HHS/HMS and HVE.

*Sage Creek or Elkhead Routes will pickup students in Golden Meadows, depending on bus capacity used on those routes. **Golden Meadows:** After leaving HVE., south on Poplar St., south on Harvest Dr., north on Poplar St. to HHS/HMS and HVE.
